INSTRUCTIONS

The purpose of the MATINS AND VESPERS is a deeper trust in Christ by His Gospel. By this trust we know Him, and with this trust we serve Him. What is the Gospel?

The Good News

that Jesus Christ is Lord and Savior.

that Christ has died, Christ is risen, and Christ will come again,

And that the forgiveness of sins and the gift of the Holy Spirit is now offered in His Name.

This Good News is not just information. It is the Light by which He is revealed and the Bread by which He gives Himself to us. And it is made a living and active Word by the power of the Holy Spirit in the Fellowship of believers.

The job of this Good News is to rescue our trust in Him, shepherd our attention toward Him, and to give us to each other in His Name.

The Gospel comes to us through the words of Scripture, both in the Old Testament promises of a good king, a new heart, and a return home, and in the New Testament announcement that Christ is the fulfillment of all those promises. Scripture itself tells us its job is to create and deepen our faith in Christ: *"But these are written that you may believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God and by believing you may have life in His Name." JOHN 20:31*

With MATINS AND VESPERS we recite this Good News to ourselves to each other.

MATINS is a liturgy for the morning, and VESPERS is a liturgy for the evening, each is made up of three things,

1) confession of sin, 2) the promises of Scripture, and 3) the prayers of others.

MATINS AND VESPERS can be done alone or in a group. If in a group, assign a reader to read either MATINS AND VEPSERS. Other members of

the group read the bold portions. Some passages change depending on the day of the week, but it always clear which of those passages to read.

The group or individual can make a choice on which psalms to read for the psalm of the day or which scriptures to read for the "Lesson." If meeting regularly, it is often beneficial to move through the *psalms one by one, and through a Gospel day by day or meeting by meeting*.

If meeting regularly, it customary to allot 30 minutes for doing either MATINS or VESPERS. Groups may catch up and chit chat before starting. There are two points in service where the group encourage to talk: there is chance to reflect on the scripture, and then later a chance to offer prayer requests. These opportunities are marked in the service.

It is sometimes beneficial to think of morning and evening prayer as involving "steps," as everything always happens in order and you simply move from one to the next, each step has a heading in all caps.

THOUGHTS OR REFLECTION ON

SCRIPTURE people may discuss what stood out in their hearing of Scripture before moving on to the Apostles' Creed THE APOSTLES' CREED, a summary of Scripture I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day He rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

FOR THOSE IN BONDAGE TO ADDICTION

O blessed Lord, you ministered to all who came to you: Look with compassion upon those who through addiction have lost their health and freedom. Restore to them the assurance of your unfailing mercy; remove from them the fears that beset them; strengthen them in the work of their recovery; and to those who minister to them, give patient understanding and persevering love; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

FOR THE ELDERLY

Lord Jesus Christ, by your patience in suffering you hallowed earthly pain and gave us the example of obedience to your Father's will: Be near us in our time of weakness and pain; sustain us by your grace, that our strength and courage may not fail; heal us according to your will; and help us always to believe that what happens to us here is of little account if you hold us in eternal life, our Lord and our God. **Amen.**

Heavenly Father, sustainer of our life and source of our hope: Comfort and relieve all who endure long term illness or persistent handicap [especially ____]. Give your grace to all who minister to their needs, that they may

be strengthened in their weakness and have confidence in your loving care; through him who knows our weakness and has shared our sorrows, Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

FOR THE DISCOURAGED AND DOWNCAST

O God, almighty and merciful, you heal the broken-hearted and turn the sadness of the sorrowful to joy, Let your fatherly goodness be upon all whom you have made. Remember in pity all those who are this day destitute, homeless, elderly, infirm, or forgotten. Bless the multitude of your poor. Lift up those who are cast down. Mightily befriend innocent sufferers, and sanctify to them the endurance of their wrongs. Cheer with hope all who are discouraged or downcast, and by your heavenly grace preserve from failing those whose poverty tempts them to sin. Though they suffer on every side, suffer them not to be distressed; though they are perplexed, save them from despair. Grant this, O Lord, for the love of him who for our sakes became poor, your Son our Savior Jesus Christ. **Amen.**

FOR THE RECOVERY OF A SICK PERSON Almighty and immortal God, giver of life and health: We implore your mercy for your servant, that by your blessing upon him and upon those who minister to him with your healing gifts, he may be restored to health of body and mind, according to your gracious will, and may give thanks to you in your holy Church; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

FOR THE SANCTIFICATION OF ILLNESS Sanctify, O Lord, the sickness of your servant, that the sense of *his* weakness may add strength to *his* faith and seriousness to *his* repentance; and grant that *he* may live with you in everlasting life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

FOR THOSE WHO LIVE ALONE

Almighty God, whose Son had nowhere to lay his head: Grant that all those who live alone may not be lonely in their solitude, but that, following in his steps, they may find fulfillment in loving you and their neighbors; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

FOR PRISONERS

FOR RELIANCE ON GOD'S POWER IN THE MIDST OF ADVERSITY

O Lord God, who sees that we put not our trust in anything that we do; Mercifully grant that by thy power we may be defended against all adversity, through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.** FOR THOSE WHO MOURN TO NOT BE OVERWHELMED Most merciful God, whose wisdom is beyond our understanding: deal graciously with those who mourn. Surround them with your love, that they may not be overwhelmed by their loss, but have confidence in your goodness, and strength to meet the days to come; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

FOR TRUST IN THE MIDST OF THINGS WE DO NOT UNDERSTAND

Help us, we pray, O Lord, in the midst of things we cannot understand, to believe and trust in the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, and the resurrection to life everlasting. Through Jesus Christ Our Lord. **Amen.**

FOR THE AWARENESS OF THE UNCERTAINTIES OF HUMAN LIFE

O God, whose days are without end, and whose mercies cannot be numbered: Make us, we pray, deeply aware of the shortness and uncertainty of human life; and let your Holy Spirit lead us in holiness and righteousness all our days, through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

FOR THE COMFORT OF THOSE IN MISERY AND AFFLICTION Gracious God, the comfort of all who sorrow, the strength of all who suffer: Let the cry of those in misery and need come to you, that they may find your mercy present with them in all their afflictions; and give us, we pray, the strength to serve them for the sake of him who suffered for us, your Son Jesus Christ our Lord **Amen.**

FOR FORGIVING OTHERS AS WE SUFFER

O Glorious Lord, your servant Stephen looked up to heaven and prayed for his persecutors: Grant that in all our sufferings here upon earth we may love and forgive our enemies, looking steadfastly to Jesus Christ our Lord, who sits at your right hand and intercedes for us; and who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. **Amen.**

FOR A SICK CHILD

Lord Jesus Christ, Good Shepherd of the sheep, you gather the lambs in your arms and carry them in your bosom: We commend to your loving care this child. This is another day, O Lord. I know not what it will bring forth, but make me ready, Lord, for whatever it may be. If I am to stand up, help me to stand bravely. Make these words more than words, and give me the Spirit of Jesus. **Amen.**

TO NOT BE LEFT COMFORTLESS

O God, the King of glory, you have exalted your only Son Jesus Christ with great triumph to your kingdom in heaven: Do not leave us comfortless, but send us your Holy Spirit to strengthen us, and exalt us to that place where our Savior Christ has gone before; who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, in glory everlasting. **Amen.**

FOR DOUBTS AND UNCERTAINTIES
